

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR  
**POST MOUNT NATURAL GAS**  
OUTDOOR INSTALLATION

This lantern must be installed by a certified plumber to conform to local codes or in absence of local codes with the national fuel gas code ANSI Z223.1.

<p><b>FOR YOUR SAFETY</b></p> <p><b>If you smell gas:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li><b>1. Shut off gas to the appliance.</b></li><li><b>2. Extinguish any open flame.</b></li><li><b>3. If odor continues, immediately call your gas supplier.</b></li></ol>	<p><b>FOR YOUR SAFETY</b></p> <p><b>DO NOT store or use gasoline or any other flammable vapors and liquids in the vicinity of this, or any other appliance.</b></p>

**INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**

*NOTE: The minimum clearance from combustible constructions is 12" top by 6" side (excluding ornamentation).*

- 1) Adjust natural gas inlet pressure to 7.0 inches WC.
- 2) Hook-up gas supply lines with appropriate fitting to attach to 1/4" flare male connector. Gas line must be able to move up and down so lantern will slide down on to post.
- 3) Attach the post fitter to top of post with brass set screws (supplied).
